

REPORT ON NCERT VISIT

7th December 2023

The Institute of Vocational Studies arranged a field visit to the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) on Thursday, December 7, 2023. The visit was scheduled as part of the B.Ed. student's course curriculum. It was painstakingly organised under the direction of our esteemed Principal, Dr. Mandira Gupta.

The primary goals of the NCERT and its component organisations are to carry out, support, encourage, and organise research in fields pertaining to school education, It writes and publishes journals, supplemental materials, model textbooks, and other books in the same field. This was selected for the field visit because of the range of interests and educational opportunities it provides for both faculty and students. The location was visited by about 34 students as well as the teacher in charge, Ms. Sangeeta Kaushik and Ms. Nazia Hasan. At 9:30 AM, all students were instructed to congregate at the location.

Initially, every student was brought to the Central Institute of Educational Technology, or CIET. We were greeted by Dr. T.K. Learning about the many procedures, equipment, and methods that NCERT uses to deliver the highest caliber of education was a truly captivating experience.
